Notice of Late Return 2026-2027

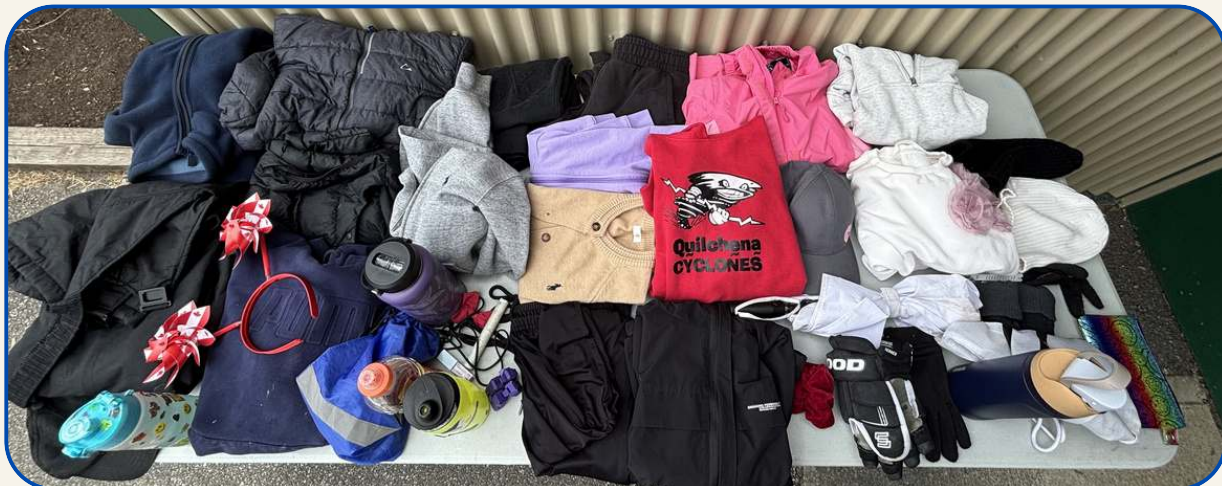
The new school year starts on Tuesday, September 8, 2026 and we look forward to welcoming all students back on this date. If extenuating circumstances prevent your child from attending the first day of school, a Late Return form is available on our school website. Families should not plan for a delayed return; the form is intended only for unavoidable and extraordinary situations. In these cases, the completed Late Return form must be submitted along with a written explanation outlining the reason for the delayed return to the school office email quilchena@sd38.bc.ca.

It is the expectation that all students will be in attendance in September. Failure to do so may result in your child losing their placement at Quilchena and they may have to re-register for school upon their late return.

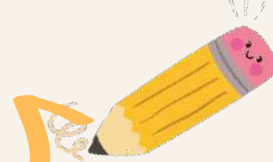

Class Placement Process 2026-2027

Each year as we enter June, we begin to make school organization plans for September based upon the number of students we know are returning, and new registrations. Before school ends in June, your child's current classroom teacher, resource staff, education assistants and administration will work together to place students for the upcoming school year. These plans are tentative until the first week in September when final student numbers are known. In the first few days of September, all staff meet again to confirm teaching assignments and review student placements.

In the organizational meetings, many factors are considered when placing students. Considerations include:

- learning styles and strengths
- social / personal characteristics
- students with special needs
- ELL Levels
- contractual obligations

As you can see, this is a complicated process, and this list is by no means exclusive, as there are many factors unique to a situation that must and will be considered.

If you would like the opportunity to provide the school with information about your child's placement for next year, you are welcome to send a letter to Mrs. Kusch at nkusch@sd38.bc.ca by Monday, June 8. We will not accept any letters that come in after June 8. The information you provide *should not include a request for a specific teacher*, but rather some important personal or educational information that will assist us in our decision.

Please be aware that the final decision regarding placement needs to be a school-based decision.

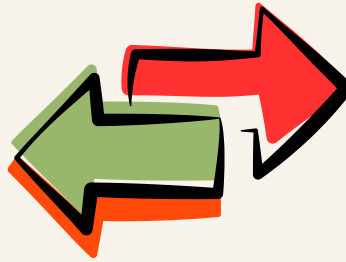
