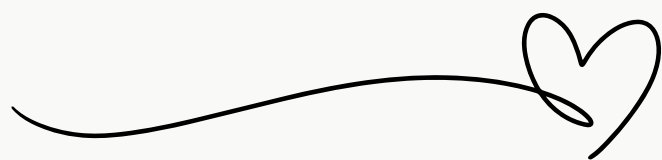

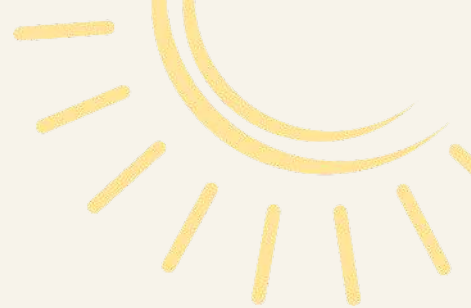

LIBRARY

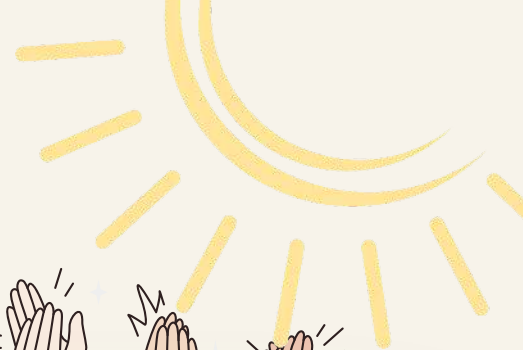


All library books are now due back to Mrs. McCormick. There are still many non-returned books. Please take a good look and return them to the library Monday.

We will be required to collect fines for non-returned items if not returned by Monday.



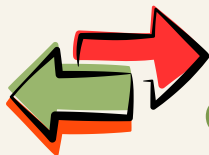
