#### **WAIT LISTS**

If a course is full, please place yourself on a Wait List using our online registration system. Click on the name of the course you wish to enroll in and select "Add to Waitlist". More sections may be opened if there is sufficient registration and if classroom space is available. You will be called only if a space becomes available.




