<u>Absences</u>: If your child(ren) will be absent from school, it is important that you call the **Student Absence line (604-718-4073)** and leave a message with your child's name, division, reason for and length of absence. This information is also posted on our school website for future use. Thank you.



<u>In Case Of:</u> As explained in several memos sent home last week, in the case of a Functional School Closure, we are preparing for the potential for a temporary closure. Information has been shared with families to ensure you can access learning opportunities during this time through MS Teams and logging into your child's Scholantis Portal.



If you would require technology, such as an iPad, to use in the event of a temporary closure, <u>please contact the school</u> <u>right away</u> so we can secure a device for you if there is a need. We do need to complete paperwork and need to have it all completed prior as we will not be able to do so at the time of a possible closure.

<u>Planning for September 2022:</u> Planning for the next school year is underway. Please check your child's backpack for our Attendance Survey (the pink form that was sent home earlier this week). Please indicate whether your children are planning to attend Quilchena next year, and return the form to school by Friday, January 21st. Students who have been absent this week will receive the form on their return to school.

Kindergarten 2022: Priority 1 Kindergarten Registration will close on January 21st, 2022. Every year there are families who miss out on this registration period resulting in their child not being able to attend their catchment school or being placed on a waitlist, both of which cause undue stress to parents and guardians and are completely avoidable. Families are strongly encouraged to register during the Priority 1 registration period for the best chance at attending their catchment school for the 2022/23 school year. As per district policy, a student will normally attend the school located in the catchment area in which their parents or legal guardians reside unless there is no physical, resource or program space available.
