This school year, all teachers will be using the same written format for communicating student learning. There will be five communication events; four Learning Updates (two written and two conferences) and one written Summary of Learning at the end of the year. We will have our first parent-teacher conferences mid-October and your child(ren)'s teacher will be sending home information on how to set a conference time shortly. Your child(ren)'s self-assessments on the core competencies will continue to be posted in their e-Portfolio. For some teachers, they may continue to use e-Portfolios to provide windows into learning throughout the school year as well.

Save the Date: Reporting Information Session for Families. There will be a District hosted virtual family information night about K-12 reporting on October 25th from 6-7 pm. We will send out the link once we receive it.

FSA's: Students in Grade 4 & 7 will be participating in the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) this month. Each year, the Ministry of Education requires school districts to conduct this province-wide assessment and is designed to see how students are progressing in the foundation skills of Reading, Writing, and Numeracy. We know this



is one assessment and only gives a snapshot of your child's learning. As a school, we use this information to further learn about your child(ren) and gives us more information about their learning.

<u>**OR Codes For School Photos:</u>** A reminder that photos orders can be made until October 14th using the QR code that was sent home with your child. If your child was absent or needs a retake, the photographers will be back on Tuesday, November 1^{st} .</u>
