Many students have been planning on what costumes they will wear and they are welcome to wear costumes if they wish. <u>Traffic Safety in School Zones:</u> Some reminders in keeping our Quilchena families and community members safe when arriving and leaving school.



Drivers

Stick to the Speed Limit: A 30 km/h speed limit is in effect in school zones from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. every school day, unless otherwise posted. In playground zones, a 30 km/h speed limit is in effect every

day from dawn to dusk.

Scan Crosswalks and Intersections from Left to Right as You Approach: Watch for pedestrians waiting to cross, especially during school hours.

Leave Your Phone Alone: Distraction is the leading factor for drivers in crashes involving pedestrians and cyclists.

Notice if Other Drivers are Slowing Down or Stopping: If a vehicle is stopped in front of you or in the lane next to you, they may be yielding to a pedestrian, so proceed with caution and be prepared to stop.

Pedestrians

Cross Only at Marked Crosswalks and Look Both Ways Before Crossing: Do not jaywalk or cross when it isn't your turn.

Make Eye Contact with Drivers Approaching the Crosswalk: Be certain they see you and that they've committed to slowing down to a stop.

Mr. Cooper's Pies Fundraiser: Mr. Cooper's pies have recently updated their website and prices, however, supporters of our fundraiser will still be getting their pies for our fundraiser flyer price of \$9.95 per 425g pie, if less than multiple of 12. As long as you
