<u>Christmas:</u> December 25th marks this Christian holiday to celebrate the birth of Jesus, the central figure of Christianity. Christmas is a celebration, a time for giving and not simply a day we exchange gifts. The spirit of Christmas is in the 'togetherness', it's in the thought to which you put into thinking about others it's a selfless time, where we forgive take



about others, it's a selfless time, where we forgive, take stock of what's important and become 'better' versions of ourselves. Christmas is also widely

observed in secular (nonreligious) ways. Merry Christmas to all our Quilchena families who celebrate Christmas.

Hanukkah: December 18th marks the start of this Jewish eight-day, "Festival of Lights," celebrated with a nightly menorah lighting, special prayers, and traditional fried foods. Central to the holiday is the lighting of the menorah, an eight-branched candelabrum to which one candle is added on each night of the holiday until it is ablaze with light on the eighth night. The Hebrew word Chanukah means "dedication" (also spelled Hanukkah). *Hanukkah Sameach* to those families who celebrate Hanukkah.



Kwanzaa: Kwanzaa, a weeklong Festival of Lights is rooted in African culture, and derived from a Swahili



phrase meaning, "first fruits of the harvest." A key custom during Kwanzaa is the daily lighting of the kinara. It takes place each year from December 26th through January 1st. This joyous holiday draws inspiration from time-honoured African customs and symbols, many related to harvest celebrations and community ideals of shared work, purpose, creativity, possibility, faith and celebration of togetherness. *Heri za Kwanzaa* to those families who celebrate Kwanzaa.

You may order and pay for all the days all at once. *Note that a 25 cents fee is charged for one credit card transaction, so we suggest that you order for all the days in one transaction rather than several transactions or you will be charged each time.* The same goes for if you have several children in the Hotlunches system; order for all your children first, then pay once.

Please note that once food orders are paid for, there are no refunds (ie. your child is sick or absent), however, you are free to pick up your child's food at the school or let the school know you'd like to donate it to the PAC or school staff that day.
