A Note from the Library: In celebration of World Book Day on Sunday April 23rd, the Quilchena Library will



<u>Student Learning Survey 2022-2023:</u> The Provincial Student Learning Survey is unique in its scope, size and usefulness to schools. It is for students in grade 4, 7, 10, and 12, their parents, staff and administrators. It gathers information from parents/guardians/caregivers, teachers, and students on topics related to school

environment, safety, and achievement. The information is used for planning in individual schools and provides a district and provincial perspective.

The Student Learning Survey will be administered to students in grades 4 and 7 in the coming weeks at school. We encourage parents/guardians/caregivers to complete a survey if they have a child(dren) in Grades 4, 7, 10, and 12. A parent may complete a survey for each child in the targeted grades and the parent survey is available in English and 17 other languages. These results are important in identifying and celebrating current strengths, as well as determining where the school needs to focus improvement. The surveys contain standard questions for the Province – in addition, questions from the school and/or district that focus on local conditions.

The survey can be completed electronically and can be accessed on any computer with an internet connection, and access to the e-survey is simple and secure. The survey can be accessed through the link without a login code by selecting the Direct Access with your school district and school name where your child(ren) attends school.






