In Other Quilchena News:



<u>Dussehra:</u> Dussehra, also called Dasara or Vijayadashami, in Hinduism, is the holiday marking the triumph of good over evil. The festival's name is derived from the Sanskrit words dasha ("ten") and hara ("defeat"). It follows the nine-day celebration of Navaratri. Wishing all our Quilchena families who celebrate this holiday a happy and promising Dussehra!

Kol Nidrei & Yom Kippur: Kol Nidrei is a prayer evening that ushers in the Jewish holiday, Yom Kippur. Yom Kippur means "Day of Atonement" in Hebrew. This is the holiest Jewish holiday of the year and ends the ten days of High Holidays or "Days of Awe," which begin with Rosh Hashanah. Traditionally, this is a time where Jewish people refrain from work and all adults fast from sundown the evening before Yom Kippur until nightfall the next day. On the day of Yom Kippur itself, there are many traditional prayers. Yom Tov to our Quilchena families who recognize this holiday.



Sukkot: Sukkot is one of the three major festivals in Judaism. It is a festival for giving thanks for many things, like food and shelter. The holiday celebrates the farmer's yearly harvest, which takes place in the fall.

<u>Game of Apps:</u> Have you ever wondered how technology products are built, what skills and abilities are required, and what the various career options are available in technology? Join us at **Game of Apps** (season 08) where professional software developers and product designers teach and mentor students on a weekly basis. You will learn coding and design skills, as well as important soft skills such as teamwork, communication, critical thinking, problem solving, time management and much

Game of Apps is an after-school program that empowers students with practical technical and life skills to help them succeed in 21st century careers. Over the past seven years, we've taught coding, design and entrepreneurship skills to over 650 students from 73 schools all over BC. Everyone is welcome, both tech-oriented and non-tech oriented students (including artists, musicians, athletes, business-minded students and more)!

This season, they continue to offer the following year-long program: Intro to Programming, levels 1 & 2, grades 6-9, which is 19 weeks. In addition, they have added 6 short 4-week courses. Please see the attached flyers.

There is a registration fee (\$368 for Intro to Programming) to help cover our costs. Game of Apps have kept the fees the same for the past 5 years. SD38 will provide a \$100 subsidy for the first 50 SD38 students who register. In addition, there is an early bird discount if registration is completed by October 7. Game of Apps also have a budget for students/families who might find the fee prohibitive. In the past 7 years, Game of Apps have never turned a student away due to the costs and have always found a way to make it work.
