In Other Quilchena News:

<u>Fall Back:</u> Remember to change your clocks this weekend. Daylight Savings Time will end at 2:00am on Sunday, November 3rd. We will notice lighter mornings and it will be getting darker much earlier. This is a good time to check your smoke detectors and replace batteries if needed.



<u>After School Supervision:</u> A kind reminder to our Quilchena Families that dismissal is at 2:45pm. If you are not able to pick up your child on time, please plan for someone to do it for you. Students are NOT supervised by school staff after dismissal, as they often have meetings or extra-curricular events to attend. Students are welcome to play on the playground area after school, but we are requesting that you or someone you have made arrangements with, is supervising your child(ren). Miss Jessy, our day-care provider is employed by her families to supervise their children, she is not there to intervene in the playground disputes of unsupervised students.
