**National Day For Truth and Reconciliation:** On September 30<sup>th</sup>, we observe the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, honouring the Survivors of residential schools, their families, and the children who never returned home. As a learning community, we reaffirm our commitment to truth, remembrance, and reconciliation with Indigenous Peoples.

Note: This day is also known as Orange Shirt Day, this is a time for collective reflection and recognition of the message, "Every Child Matters". Staff and

students are encouraged to wear orange on September 29th, 2025 in solidarity.

Kol Nidrei and Yom Kippur: At sundown on October 1st, the Jewish community will begin observance of Kol Nidrei, the solemn opening service of Yom Kippur. We extend our thoughts to those preparing for this sacred time of prayer, reflection, and personal renewal. Translation note: Kol Nidrei means "All Vows." It refers to a traditional prayer recited at the start of Yom Kippur. Yom Kippur, the holiest day in the Jewish calendar. May this Day of Atonement bring peace, reflection, and renewal as you fast, pray, and gather with your communities. Translation note: Yom Kippur means "Day of Atonement."



**<u>Dussehra:</u>** We extend our warmest greetings to members of the Hindu community observing Dussehra. This festival marks the victory of good over evil and is often celebrated with prayer, cultural events, and family gatherings. May this day bring joy, prosperity, and light.


