FSA's: Students in Grade 4 & 7 will be participating in the Foundation Skills Assessment (FSA) this month. Each year, the Ministry of Education requires school districts to conduct this province-wide assessment and is designed to see how

students are progressing in the foundation skills of Reading, Writing, and Numeracy. We know this is one assessment and only gives a snapshot of your child's learning. As a school, we use this information to further learn about your child(ren) and gives us more information about their learning. An email was sent home from the District to all Grade 4 & 7 families in September with more information.
