Birthday of Guru Nanak Dev Sahib: We extend our heartfelt greetings to Sikh students, staff, and families as you celebrate the Gurmurb (birth anniversary) of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, the founder of Sikhism. May this sacred day bring peace, wisdom, and inspiration to all.

Translation note: Gurmurb combines Guru (teacher) and Murb (celebration/occasion), referring to a day that commemorates a Guru's birth or significant life event. Guru Nanak Dev Ji (ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਜੀ) is honoured as the first Sikh Guru and spiritual teacher.



Veterans' Week (Nov 5 – 11) is dedicated to honoring the courage and sacrifice of veterans who have served in wartime, military conflicts, and peacekeeping missions. It is also a time to remember those who have made the ultimate sacrifice and to acknowledge the ongoing service of those in uniform today.

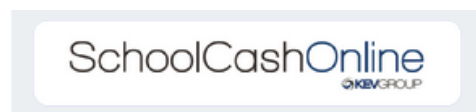

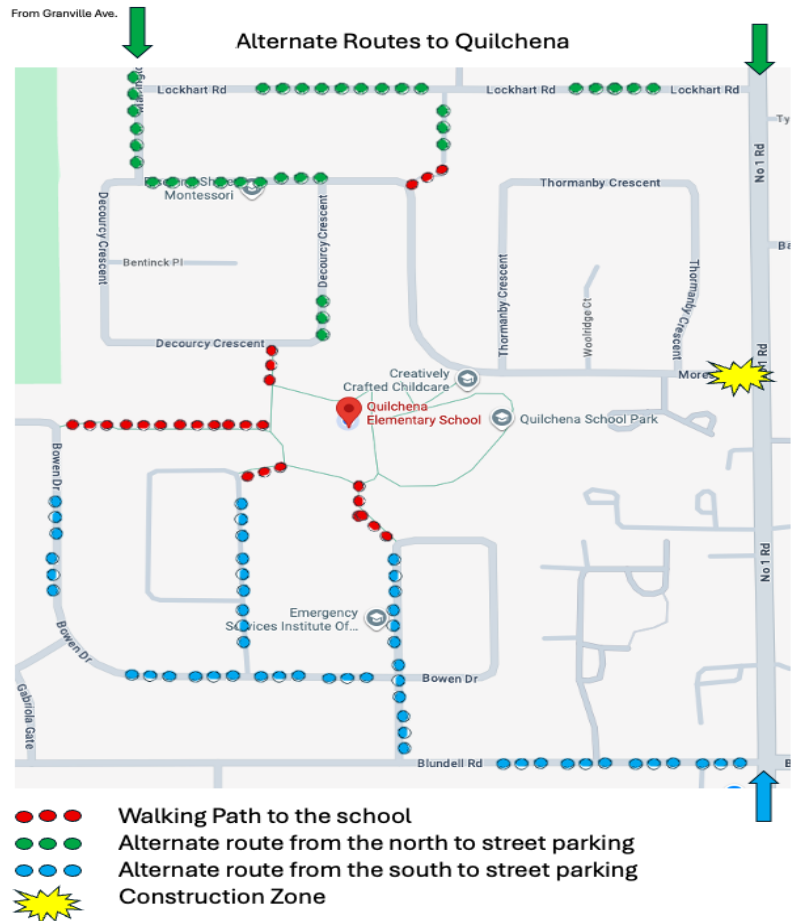
