EXTENDED ABSENCES

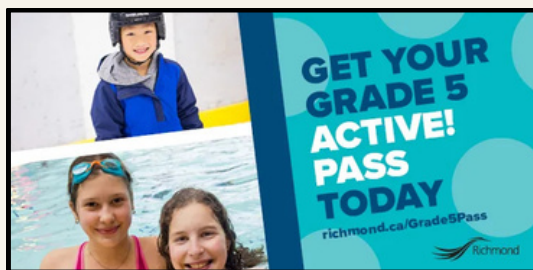
