Inclement Weather, School Closure Notifications: If needed, the district will try to determine school closures due to inclement weather by 6:30 a.m. Updates will be delivered using social media and school and district websites, Facebook Twitter. No radio or television announcement will be made saying that schools are open. Only school closures will be announced by the media. To reach as many people as possible - as quickly as possible - we work closely with our local media to share information. Please listen to local radio stations and follow local news outlets online to also get information about the impact of severe weather or emergencies in our schools.

If snowfall begins while school is in session, in most circumstances, schools will remain OPEN until the end of the school day. If schools are open, and you wish to keep your child home due to weather conditions, you may do so. Please let us know of this decision by leaving a message on our early warning phone number 604-718-4073. Do not call the school office.

Taiko Drumming Residency: On Tuesday, December 16th and Wednesday, December 17th we are very excited to welcome the Uzume Taiko drumming residency! A permission notice with full details, including cost, has been sent home with your child today. This unique in-school experience has been generously subsidized by the school to make it accessible for all families. We can't wait for our students to enjoy this dynamic and culturally rich learning opportunity!

Workshop: Taiko is a Japanese word that means "big drum". Uzume Taiko's hands-on taiko drumming experience is a comprehensive introduction to taiko drumming, with all student taiko drum gear provided. Students engage in physical warm-up exercises, martial arts stance, vocal shouts, and drum-sticking techniques. Along with rhythmic drills, verbal notation, choreography, and group song playing, students develop listening and communication skills and learn about the respect and cooperation of taiko

drumming.

DECEMBER 2: INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE ABOLITION OF SLAVERY

A day to highlight that more than 150 million children are subject to child labor and though modern slavery is not defined in law, it is used as an umbrella term covering practices such as forced labour, debt bondage, forced marriage, and human trafficking.
