The MyEd Parent Portal is used to view and access your child's Learning Update. Paper copies will not be sent home. Your MyEd Parent Portal account also gives you access to student/pupil numbers. 

Universal Hot Lunch Program: Utilizing Feeding Futures funding, as well as National School Food Program funding, the Richmond School District is piloting a Universal Hot Lunch program at selected elementary and secondary schools during the months of December and January. This is separate from our PAC Hot Lunch program and is organized at the District level.

We had our first lunch this past Wednesday and the second lunch offered to <u>all</u> students at Quilchena Elementary School will be on January 14th (order deadline January 8th). If you did not order for the January date yet, please do not forget to do so as they will not take late orders.

Travel Plans / Voluntary Student Absences: If your child will not be back to school on Monday, January 5th, 2026, please complete an Extended Leave Form prior to leaving to ensure the school office is aware of your return date. This form can be emailed to the office if you are unable to get it to us before end of day today! (quilchena@sd38.bc.ca)

We would like to remind families of the importance of student attendance. We acknowledge that there may be exceptional circumstances that necessitates a student's extended voluntary absence, but it should not be the goal of families to remove their children from school for vacations during instructional time. Missed school not only impacts your child, but also the entire class when group projects and collaboration times are affected. If voluntary absences exceed the allowable amount, your child will be withdrawn from Quilchena, requiring re-registration on your return. As well, teachers will not be providing work packages or homework for students.

If voluntary absences are unavoidable, please advise your teacher, as well as complete the Extended Leave Form <u>HERE</u> and return it to the office at least one week prior to departure. We greatly appreciate your cooperation!
