The MyEd Parent Portal is used to view and access your child's Learning Update. Paper copies will not be sent home. Your MyEd Parent Portal account also gives you access to student/pupil numbers. A quick link is available on our school website, as well as instructions on how to register for and access the MyEd Parent Portal. This will be available to download for just a few weeks so please make sure to save a copy for your records.

All registration applications received any time during the Priority 1 registration period will receive placement decisions by February 6, 2026.

Student Learning Survey 2026 - Parent Input Needed!

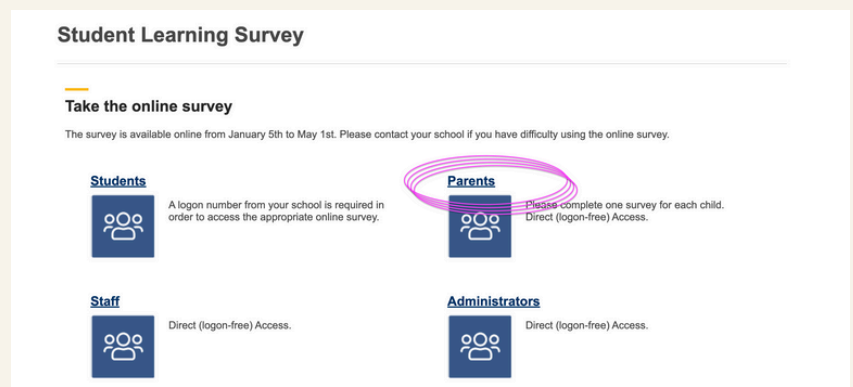
The Student Learning Survey (SLS) has been administered every year in BC public schools since 2001. The SLS provides feedback on the implementation of curriculum changes, learning environment, student wellness and satisfaction, student belonging and engagement, and career preparation. It is the only source of province-wide information of children's learning experiences. The Student Learning Survey is being administered to our students in grades 4 and 7 at school.

We also encourage parents/guardians/caregivers to complete a survey if they have a child(dren) in Grades 4, 7, 10, 11 and 12. A parent may complete a survey for each child in the targeted grades and the parent survey is available in English and 16 other languages. The parent and guardian/caregiver survey is now available online until Friday, May 1st, and will take approximately 25-30 minutes to complete. Your responses are voluntary and anonymous, and your child will not be identified as a result of your participation in the survey. Any personal or identifying information will be deleted before results are stored. Data will be stored and accessible only within Canada. [Student Learning Survey Link](#)

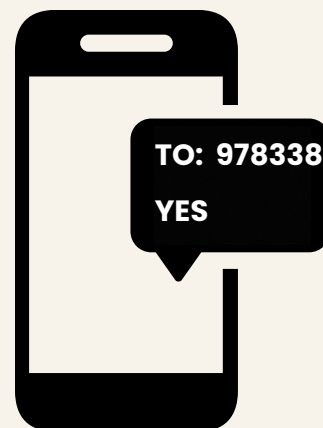

Opt-in to District/School Text Message Communication

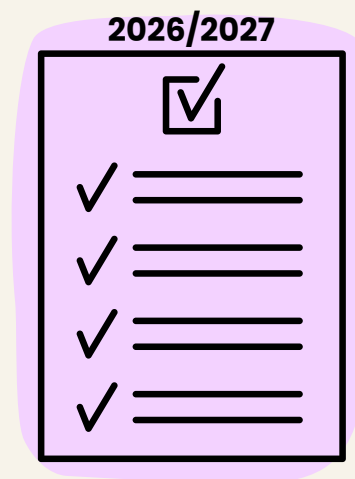

IMPORTANT & COMMEMORATIVE DAYS IN OUR COMMUNITY

JANUARY 15: BLACK EXCELLENCE DAY

Black Excellence Day started from the movement in early 2021. It is a day to stand in solidarity with Black Canadians and to learn about the contributions of Black Canadians and their ongoing civil rights struggle.

A day to honour the rich history, art, and stories of Black Canadians. The term “BlackExcellence” was born out of the civil rights movement in the 1960’s and honours great civil rights leader, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. who was born on January 15, 1929.

JANUARY 17: RAOUL WALLENBERG DAY

We remember the selfless bravery of Raoul Wallenberg, a Swedish diplomat who took the initiative to save thousands of persecuted Jews during the Second World War. In 1944, Wallenberg opened a Swedish embassy in Budapest, where 400,000 Jewish men, women and children had already been deported by the Nazis. He began his efforts to protect the Jewish community in Hungary through unconventional methods. It was under the safeguard of the embassy that he provided special protective certificates called Schutz-Passes for 4,000 Jewish people, which granted them immunity from deportation. On January 17, 1945, Wallenberg was arrested by Soviet forces as they pushed the Nazis out of Hungary. Mr. Wallenberg’s heroism is a lesson in humanity, compassion, and courage that inspires us every day to pursue our collective fight against hatred and antisemitism in all their forms.
