Needed

Track Meet notices came home earlier this week. We will need parent volunteer drivers to help transport grade 4-7 students to the track meet on Wednesday, May 27. As the process takes a bit of time, we appreciate you getting started early. Even if there's only a small chance you can drive, please complete the process now—thank you so much for your support!

Please follow the updated volunteer driver procedure outlined below.

1. Driver Authorization Form: Must be completed before driving for any school event. *Must be completed every school year.*
 2. Criminal Record Check: A quick 5-minute free online criminal record check is required. The link and the school district code necessary to submit is on our school website. CRC's are valid for two years. This requirement applies regardless of whether you currently hold a criminal record check or have completed one in the past. *Once completed, please forward your submission confirmation email to quilchena@sd38.bc.ca*
 3. Vehicle Insurance: Drivers must have a \$1 million minimum of liability coverage. *A copy of your insurance must be submitted to the school office.*
