## ***Class Placement Process 2026-2027***



Each year as we enter June, we begin to make school organization plans for September based upon the number of students we know are returning, and new registrations. Before school ends in June, your child's current classroom teacher, resource staff, education assistants and administration will work together to place students for the upcoming school year. These plans are tentative until the first week in September when final student numbers are known. In the first few days of September, all staff meet again to confirm teaching assignments and review student placements.

In the organizational meetings, many factors are considered when placing students. Considerations include:

- learning styles and strengths
- social / personal characteristics
- students with special needs
- ELL Levels
- contractual obligations

As you can see, this is a complicated process, and this list is by no means exclusive, as there are many factors unique to a situation that must and will be considered.

If you would like the opportunity to provide the school with information about your child's placement for next year, you are welcome to send a letter to Mrs. Kusch at [nkusch@sd38.bc.ca](mailto:nkusch@sd38.bc.ca) by Monday, June 8. We will not accept any letters that come in after June 8. The information you provide *should not include a request for a specific teacher*, but rather some important personal or educational information that will assist us in our decision. Please be aware that the final decision regarding placement needs to be a school-based decision.

**If you are able to help drive grade 4-7 students to the track meet on Wednesday, May 27, we appreciate you getting started now with the volunteer driver procedure outlined below. The process takes a bit of time and we thank you so much for your support.**

You can locate instructions and the Driver form on our school website under the [Parents tab > School Resources > School Forms](#).

1. Driver Authorization Form: Must be completed before driving for any school event. *Must be completed every school year.*
2. Criminal Record Check: A quick 5-minute free online criminal record check is required. We will provide the link and the school district code necessary to submit. CRC's are valid for two years. This requirement applies regardless of whether you currently hold a criminal record check or have completed one in the past. *Once completed, please forward your submission confirmation email to [quilchena@sd38.bc.ca](mailto:quilchena@sd38.bc.ca)*
3. Vehicle Insurance: Drivers must have a \$1 million minimum of liability coverage. *A copy of your insurance must be submitted to the school office.*

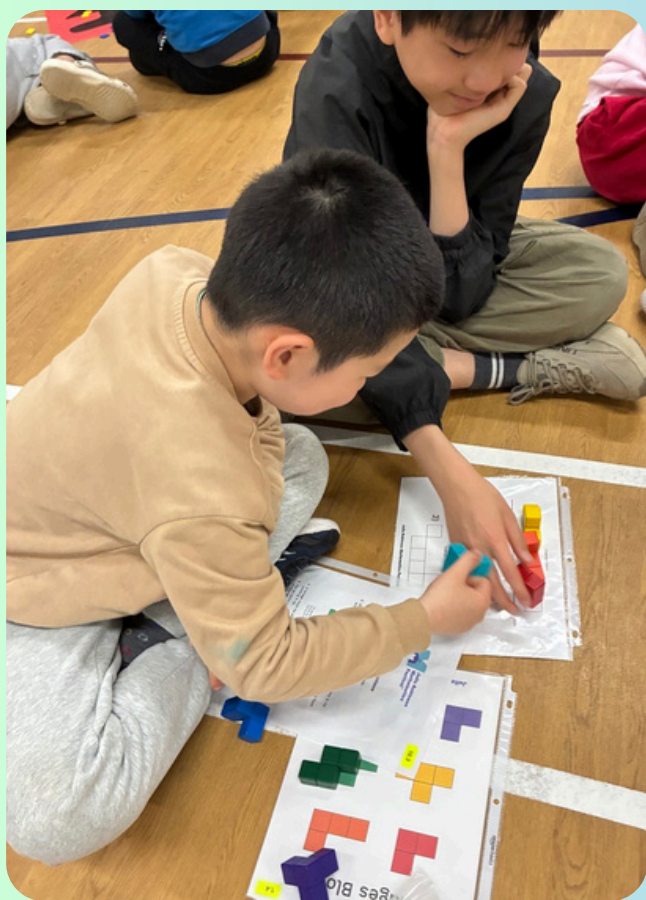
