CYCLONE DAY AND BIKE PARADE

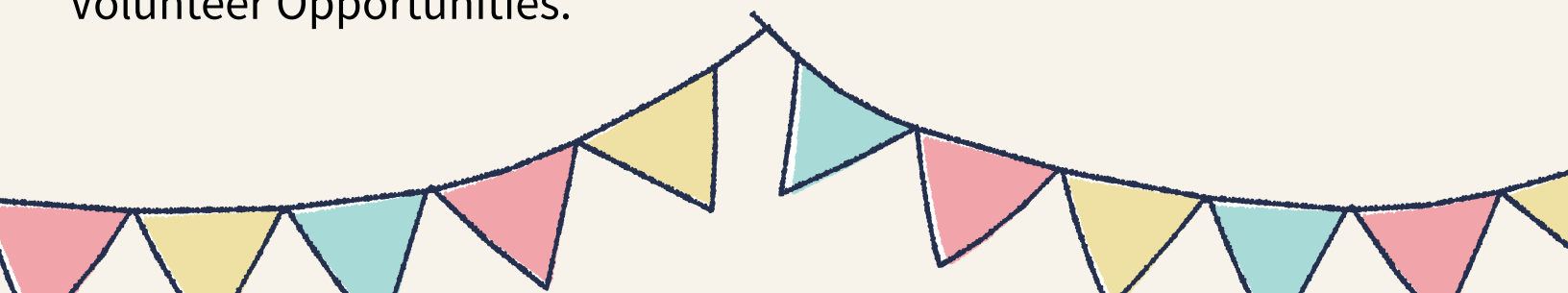

Class Placement Process 2026-2027

Each year as we enter June, we begin to make school organization plans for September based upon the number of students we know are returning, and new registrations. Before school ends in June, your child's current classroom teacher, resource staff, education assistants and administration will work together to place students for the upcoming school year. These plans are tentative until the first week in September when final student numbers are known. In the first few days of September, all staff meet again to confirm teaching assignments and review student placements.

In the organizational meetings, many factors are considered when placing students. Considerations include:

- learning styles and strengths
- social / personal characteristics
- students with special needs
- ELL Levels
- contractual obligations

As you can see, this is a complicated process, and this list is by no means exclusive, as there are many factors unique to a situation that must and will be considered.

If you would like the opportunity to provide the school with information about your child's placement for next year, you are welcome to send a letter to Mrs. Kusch at nkusch@sd38.bc.ca by Monday, June 8. We will not accept any letters that come in after June 8. The information you provide *should not include a request for a specific teacher*, but rather some important personal or educational information that will assist us in our decision.

Please be aware that the final decision regarding placement needs to be a school-based decision.

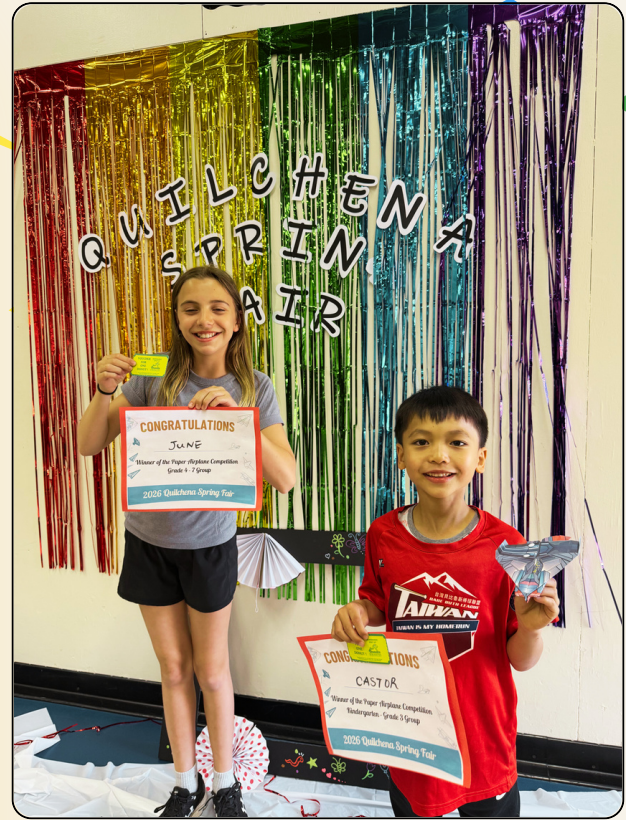
PAC SPRING FAIR – THANK YOU!

JUNE 2026

National Indigenous History Month: A time to recognize the rich history, heritage and diversity of First Nations, Inuit and Métis.

Italian Heritage Month: People from across the country will have an opportunity to honour and celebrate Italian Heritage Month, a time to recognize the community's contributions to building the strong, vibrant, and consciously more inclusive country we know today.

Filipino Heritage Month: Every June, we celebrate Filipino Heritage Month, an important time to recognize and highlight the many invaluable contributions Canadians of Filipino heritage make each and every day to the country we call home.

Portuguese Heritage Month: From politics to art and sport to cuisine, Canadians of Portuguese heritage continue to have a positive impact on our country each and every day in towns and cities across our great country.



LAUNCH OF PRIDE SEASON

Pride Season refers to the wide range of Pride events that take place from June to September, when 2SLGBTQI+ people and their allies come together to highlight the resilience, celebrate the talent, and recognize their communities' contributions. Although special attention is put on the Pride events during the summer months, they happen throughout the year in many communities.

Historically, Pride gatherings emerged from the first large-scale protests for 2SLGBTQI+ rights. In Canada, the first demonstrations took place in Ottawa and Vancouver in 1971. By 1973, Pride events were held in several Canadian cities, including Montreal, Ottawa, Saskatoon, Toronto, Vancouver and Winnipeg. Toronto's Pride weekend in June is now among the largest Pride events in North America.
