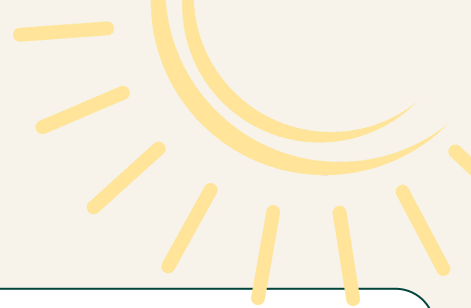


Notice of Late Return 2026-2027

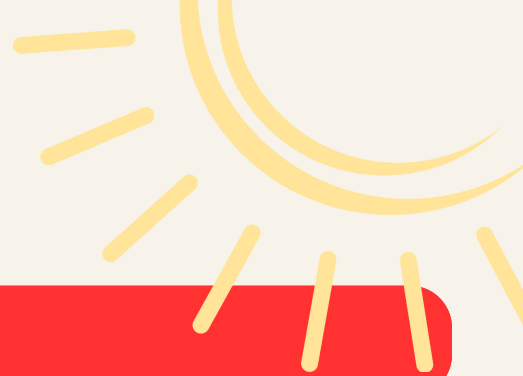

On June 21st, we recognize and celebrate National Indigenous Peoples Day, honouring the rich cultures, traditions, languages, and contributions of First Nations, Inuit, and Métis Peoples across Canada. This day is an opportunity to learn, reflect, and celebrate the strength, diversity, and ongoing presence of Indigenous communities.

June 21st was chosen to coincide with the summer solstice, a day of cultural and spiritual significance for many Indigenous Peoples. It is a time to celebrate identity, heritage, and community.
